<b>Go to the "Final Approval Hearing"</b>	<p>The Court will hold a Final Approval Hearing to consider the Settlement, the request by the lawyers who brought the Action ("Class Counsel") for attorneys' fees and expenses, and Plaintiffs' request for Service Payments for bringing the Action.</p> <p>You may, but are not required to, speak at the Final Approval Hearing about any Objection you filed. If you intend to speak at the Final Approval Hearing, you must follow the procedures set forth in <a href="#">FAQ 36</a> when you serve your Objection.</p>
<b>Do Nothing</b>	<p>If you do nothing, you will not be eligible to receive a cash payment. However, if the Settlement is approved by the Court, you will give up your rights to sue Zoom for claims that are released by this Settlement as described in <a href="#">FAQ 23</a>.</p>
